11th Annual MONOPOLY® Tournament Proceeds to Benefit Children with Disabilities

Fulton, Grand Rapids, MI 49503. Check in opens at 11:30 am with games beginning at 12:00 Noon. Proceeds benefit children with disabilities who receive summer therapy at Therapy and Fun.

Comprehensive Therapy Center and ΑΣΑ hope to raise over \$5,000 for scholarships through the sponsorship of this day-long competition. The tournament includes two 90-minute preliminary rounds of the MONOPOLY game, as well as a final round of play between the top six competitors, which determines the winner. Thanks to previous tournaments, over \$34,000 in scholarships have been distributed to children in need.

A seat at the tournament is only \$25 but if you gather at least \$50 from friends and family (like a walk-a-thon) the registration fee is WAIVED! Children with disabilities will benefit from your fund raising efforts. The player backed by the most donations wins the top prize! Of course there are prizes for the winners of the Tournament, too.
