Therapy and Fun Clinic: June 18 to August 2

Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays - 9:00am to 12:00pm, Each Morning

Our morning is divided into six sessions. Each therapy session is based on your child's specific needs and includes speech-language, gross motor and fine motor, and/or sensory integration.

When not in therapy, children practice new skills in crafts, reading, or musical activities. Our highly trained teen volunteers become your child's friend in therapy. In 2011, 79% of all goals written for the children were met.

Frequently Asked Questions

Who may attend? Children who need speech, language, motor, or sensory therapy – from simple to complex issues. Ages: 1 to 12 years old.

Is there a cost? Yes. We only charge for the therapy your child receives and for the screening appointment. We accept insurance from many companies and have a sliding fee, if needed.

How do we get started? Call our office at (616) 559-1054 to schedule a screening appointment where we meet you and your child and review your child's school and medical reports.

May I visit the program? Absolutely! We love it when you spend time with us. We even have a special Grandparents' Day.

Are there other opportunities for parents? Yes. We have workshops Tuesdays at 9:00am to discuss topics such as: discipline, therapies, special education, siblings, financial planning, or make-it take-it crafts.

Call Early. Mandatory screenings begin in April. Insurance authorization and payment schedule must be completed before therapy begins.
